

Present simple

Definition:

The present simple it's a verbal time in english. We use the present simple to:

Habits and routines that happen often

Actions that happen in the moment

Structure:

Affirmative

Auxiliar do/does + subject + verb + complement

Negative

Subject + verb + complement

Interrogative

Subject + auxiliar don't/ doesn't + verb + complement

Third person:

- Verbs ending in -o, -sh, -ch, -ss, -x, -z → it's added
- Verbs ending in -y and preceded by consonant → it's added
- Verbs ending in -y and preceded by vowel → it's added
- General rule → it's added

- Maria (don't run) in the park.
- Pepe always (ask) at the university?
