ACTIVITY 3: Read the text. Answer: what chores do Adam and Sally don't like doing?

Hi, my name is Adam. I'm 8 years old. I live with my family in a big house. I have one sister, Mary, and one brother, Paul. Mary is 12 years old and Paul is 14 years old.

We share many chores with our mum and dad. Paul and I **take the garbage out**. My mother and father cook for the family. But sometimes me, my brother and my sister **help to cook**. I **sweep the floor** every morning. Mary **feeds the pets** every day.



Mary and Paul take turns to **wash the dishes**: Mary **washes the dishes** on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and Paul **washes the dishes** on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. On Sundays it is my turn to **wash the dishes**. I **don't like** washing the dishes but it is important to help my family.

Hello, my name is Sally. I'm 10 years old. My family is small: my mother, my father, my brother John and me. John is 12 years old. We live in a small house in California.

In my house, all the family helps with the chores. My brother and I **make the bed** in the morning. I **tidy my bedroom** on Sundays and Wednesdays. John **feeds the pets** every morning and I **feed the pets** every afternoon. We have one cats and two dogs.



My father cooks for the family and John and I **help to cook** every day. My mother **sets the table**. My mother works every day and she is very tired during the week. But on Sundays she cooks for us. John and I **wash the dishes** every day.

I **like** feeding my pets but I **don't like** tidying my bedroom.
