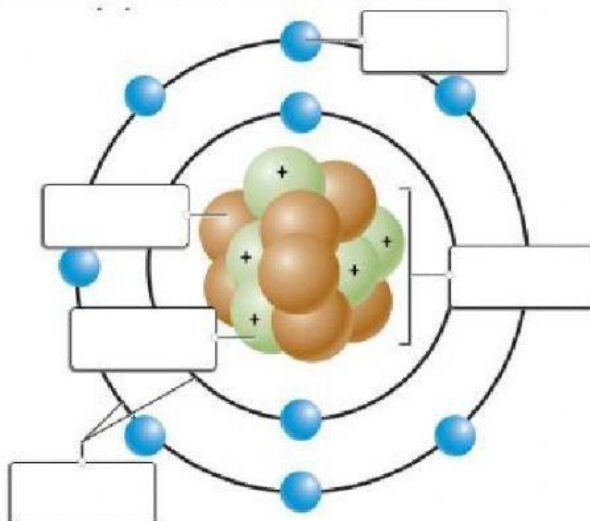


Introduction to Atoms Worksheet

Atoms	Negatively charged particles outside the nucleus of an atom
Protons	Number of protons in an atom
Atomic Number	Neutral particles found in nucleus of an atom
Mass number	The smallest unit of matter
Isotopes	A substance composed of one type of atom
Electrons	Positively charged particles in the nucleus of an atom
Neutrons	The number of protons plus neutrons in the nucleus of an atom
Elements	Variations of elements that have the same number of protons but different numbers of neutrons

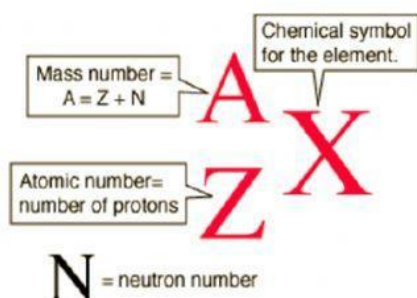
