We use superlative adjectives to compare one thing or person to lots of other things or people.

	Adjective	+ superlative	– superlative
Regular adjectives	mean	the meanest	the least mean
Two syllable adjectives ending in -y	happy	the happiest	the least happy
Two or more syllable adjectives	interesting	the most interesting	the least interesting
Irregular adjectives	good bad	the best the worse	–
