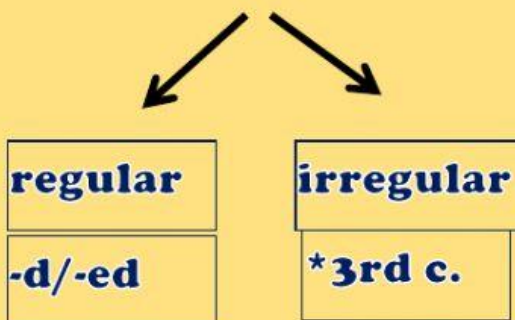

eat	→	have/has	eaten
break	→	have/has	broken
watch	→	have/has	watched
