BOY: Stir-fry? That's not very healthy.

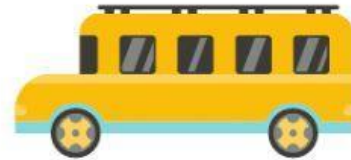


GIRL: I know. But I don't eat it that \_\_\_\_\_.
