### Affirmative sentences

I'm	wearing	a brightly-coloured jacket.
He's / She's		
You're / We're / They're		helmets.

### Contractions

'm = am	I'm
's = is	he's she's it's
're = are	we're they're

### Negative sentences

I'm not	cycling	on the road.
He / She isn't		on the pavement.
You / We / They aren't		

The auxiliary verb in the present continuous is be (am, is, are).

Are you	playing cricket?	Yes,	I am.	No,	I'm not.
Is he / she	surfing?		he / she is.		he / she isn't.
Are we / they	kayaking?		we / they are.		we / they aren't.
