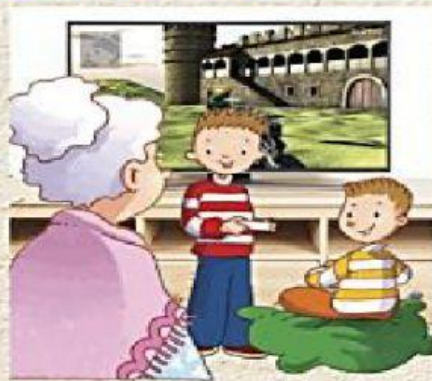


LAST SUNDAY...
