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Rugby Rules

Object of the Game:

- Your team score more overall points than the opposite team.
- Games end / finish as a draw.
- The ball never be passed forwards (= *en avant*) but players run forwards with the ball or kick the ball forward to chase it down.
- The opposing team stop the attacking team by tackling (= *en plaquant*) and trying to keep the ball.

Players & Equipment:

- Each rugby team consists of 15 players. The team is split /divided into two groups: the forwards and backs.
- Each team wear the same coloured jerseys (= *maillots*), shorts and socks.

Rules of Rugby:

- Injured players (=blessés) to return playing if they have been treated (= *soignés*).
- The game have one referee (= *un arbitre*) and two touch judges.
- A tackle (= *plaquage*) be made above shoulder height (= *hauteur d'épaule*).
- Attacking players play before the ball : offside (= *hors jeu*).

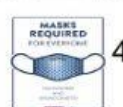
