Past continuous

Let's take a closer look.

Look at the past continuous tense in **bold**.


We use the past continuous tense to talk about something that was happening at a particular point in the past.

Sami started to feel seasick while he **was traveling** on a boat to the Great Barrier Reef.

Here are some more examples of an event in progress at a particular point in the past.

When we arrived at the restaurant, David **was eating** a pizza.

We **were playing** a game when the dog jumped on the table.

How we use the past continuous

Look at how we use the past continuous.


We use the past continuous to describe one ongoing longer action interrupted by another action.

I was sleeping when the thunder woke me up.



The past continuous often appears with the past simple.

We were walking on the beach when I stumbled on a rock.



Notice at how we join sentences with *when*.

Background events

We often use the past continuous to describe events and actions that were happening in the background.



We use the past continuous to describe a scene at the start of a story.

Our first day on vacation was amazing. The sun was shining. Josh and Alicia were building a sandcastle. Other children were playing limbo. Everyone was having fun, and I decided to go for a swim.
