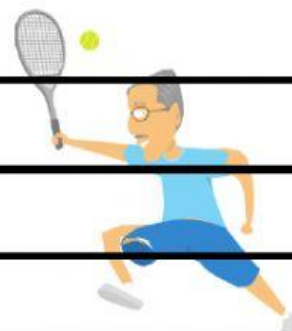

Conjunctions	Usage	Example
for	TO give reasons (like because)	I stayed at home, for I was sick.
and	TO join words or ideas together	He can play Tennis, and he can teach you
but, yet	TO join contrast words or ideas	The Test was long, but I COULD DO IT WELL
or	TO talk about choices	You can't swim, or you can die
NOR	TO express similar negative meaning	She isN'T overweight, nor is she slim
so	TO show result	I woke up late, so I missed the bus.

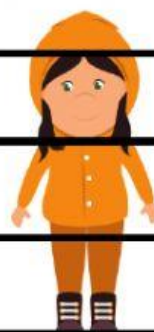
