Affirmative

I like cookies.
You like flowers.
We like English.
They like secrets.

Negative

I don't like cookies.
You don't like flowers.
We don't like English.
They don't like secrets.



He likes spiders.
She likes Music.
It likes bones.

He **doesn't** like spiders.
She **doesn't** like Music.
It **doesn't** like bones.
