

I have not got

<p><b>HAVE GOT</b> AFFIRMATIVE</p>  <p>I have got a good friend.</p>	<p><b>HAVE GOT</b> AFFIRMATIVE</p>  <p>Dad, you have got a doughnut.</p>
<p><b>HAVE GOT</b> AFFIRMATIVE</p>  <p>He has got a skateboard.</p>	<p><b>HAVE GOT</b> AFFIRMATIVE</p>  <p>She has got a book.</p>
