**Pronouncing words with n sound
Using Question words or Wh question**

This Learning Activity Sheet is about pronouncing words with n sound, and using question words or **Wh questions**. This LAS aims to hone the skills of the pupils in speaking, writing and grammar. The words above begin with the consonant letter n sound.

nap, nose and net begin with the n sound while fan, baron and van end with the n sound.

C. USING QUESTION WORDS or WH QUESTIONS

- Are words used to ask or write questions.
- They end with a question mark (?)
- **WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN,** and **WHY** are question words.


Read the sentences below.

What is the name of your pet?



The name of my pet is Oreo.

Hi Glen! Where is the house of Mr. Spongebob?



Oh Hi Cara. His house is just two blocks away from here.

When to use the WH questions correctly?

- a. **WHAT**- is used to ask about an object, an event, or an animal.

Examples: **What** do you use in writing?
What is your name?

- b. **WHO** – is used to ask about a person.

Examples: **Who** is your teacher?
Who is your best friend?

- c. **WHEN** – ask about time.

Examples: **When** is your birthday?
When is Valentines Day?

- d. **WHERE** – is used to ask about a place.

Examples: **Where** did you buy that shoes John?
Where is Mount Apo?

- e. **WHY** – asks about a reason.

Examples: **Why** are you early today?
Why do you go to school?
