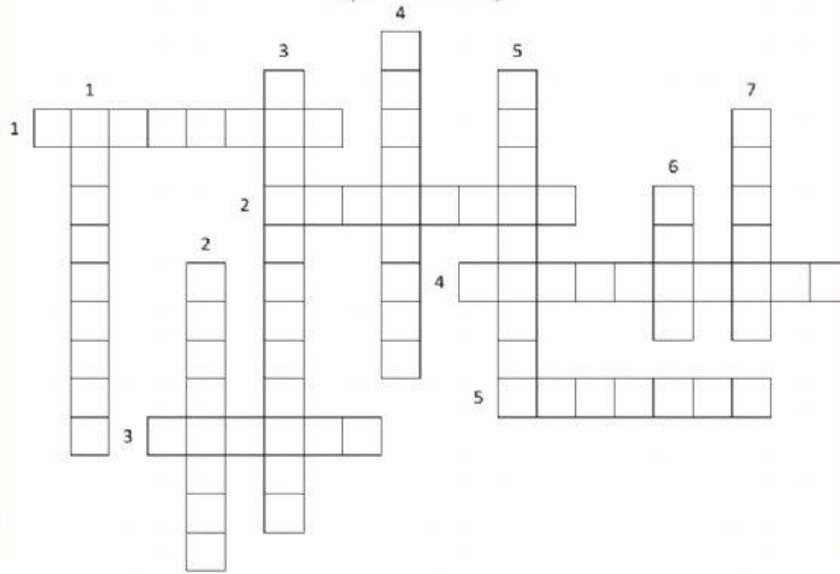


NEW YEAR'S EVE
