A history of school uniform

- A** The pros and cons of a school uniform are always a hot topic of discussion. Is it more important to express your personality or follow rules and look smart? Whatever you think, let's investigate the history of the school uniform.
- B** England was the first country to introduce uniforms for school children, in 1552. Christ's Hospital School, a school for poor children in London, introduced a uniform of blue coats and yellow socks. The coats were blue because it was the cheapest material.
- C** In 1870, in England and Wales, a new law said that all children must go to school. All schools had uniforms. Boys wore short trousers and long socks – and often a hat. Girls wore dresses. Boys' hair was always short and girls' long hair was tidy.
- D** School uniforms changed greatly in the early 20th century. Boys wore long trousers. Girls wore shirts and skirts. Both boys and girls often wore ties and special jackets. Some private schools introduced smart, formal uniforms. Students at Eton College wore very formal black hats and long black coats.
- E** Towards the end of the 20th century, school uniforms became more casual. In many schools, girls and boys could wear trainers instead of smart school shoes. Girls were finally allowed to wear trousers. What do you think will be the next trend?
