### COUNTABLE NOUNS

Have a singular and plural form

→ a tree      two trees

Can use a *singular* verb or  
a *plural* verb

→ The **book** *is* old.

→ The **books** *are* old.

We can count

### UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

Have only one form (no plural)

→ butter      butters

Always use a singular verb

→ **Sugar** *is* sweet.

Cannot use *a*, *an* or *a number*  
before them

→ **a** rice      **two** rice  
→ **a** bread      **two** bread


#### SOME FOOD (cut into small parts)




