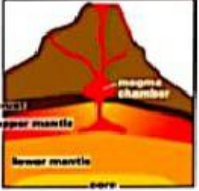


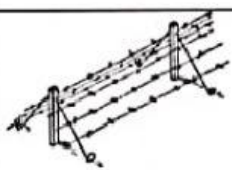

picture	Word	Definition
	Mountain	A very high part of the land which is higher than a hill.
	Lava	Hot, liquid rock getting out of a volcano.
	Dormant	Asleep. e.g. Dormant volcano: inactive volcano.
	Hard	Not easy. It can't break easily. Solid.
	Block	Stop something getting by.
	Magma	Hot, molten rock that moves up from deep inside the Earth and pours out of the vent.
	Erupt	Explode.

	Volcano	Usually a mountain with an opening where hot liquid and ash are poured out.
	Vent	A hole in the top of a volcano.
	Crack	A line that appears before breaking something.
	Smoke	A grey, black, or white cloud comes when we burn something.
	Grumble	Complain about something in a bad-tempered way.
	Molten	Changing from solid to liquid.
	Deep	A long way down from the top of something.
	Ash	The grey powder that remains after burning something.
	Explode	Burst with great force making loud sound.

	Pour out	To have a liquid out of its container or its place.
	Wire	Along thin piece of metal.
	Umpire	A person who sees that the rules of a game are obeyed.
	Journey	The act of travelling from one place to another.
	Tire	The rubber part that fits around a wheel of a car or a bicycle.
	Hire	To pay to use something for a short period.
	Damage	To harm or spoil something.

	Grow	Get bigger and bigger.
	High	Tall like high mountains.
	Long ago	Long time in the past.

	Young	Not old.
	Push away	To push something or someone away of its place.
	Flow	A continuous movement of a liquid.
	Nearby	Not far away.
