



### An Interesting Country

Iceland is in the North Atlantic (1) **Ocean** / **Lake**, south of the Arctic Circle. The (2) **environment** / **mountain** is very important to the people who live there.

(3) **Hills** / **Glaciers** cover about 11.5% of the country. They are made of ice. Hvannadalshnúkur is the highest (4) **mountain** / **river** in Iceland. It is 6,926 feet high. Many people like to climb it. There are also (5) **hills** / **lakes**, where Icelandic horses live.

People can ride these horses or use them for farm work.

Water is important in Iceland. People can use the fast movement of water in (6) **rivers** / **glaciers** to get hot water for their homes. They can also get fish from the country's (7) **oceans** / **lakes**. There are about 60 of them in Iceland.
