

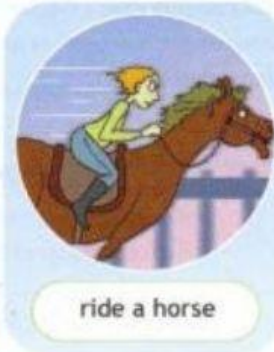

- 10 What time (you/get up) on Sundays?

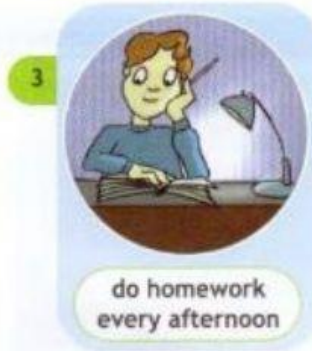
