♥ Maple syrup


- ♥ Nutella

4. Pour in enough batter to cover bottom of pan in a thin layer (when you pour it in, quickly hold and turn the pan to even out batter into a circle)
5. Flip when golden
6. Spread on your topping of choice the roll – for example: jam; whipped cream and fresh fruit; maple syrup; fresh fruit, a sprinkling of powdered sugar; nutella.
