Yes, **I** have. ✓

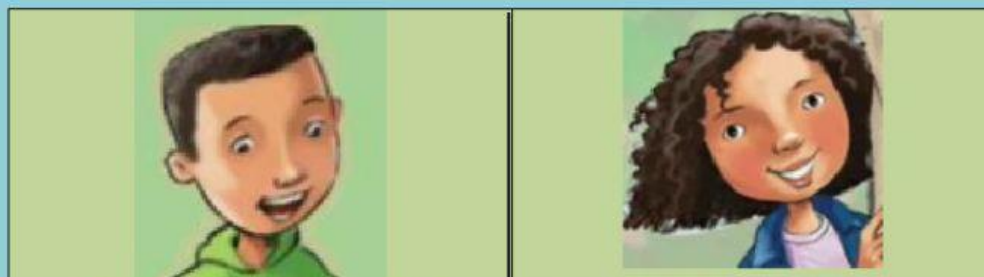
