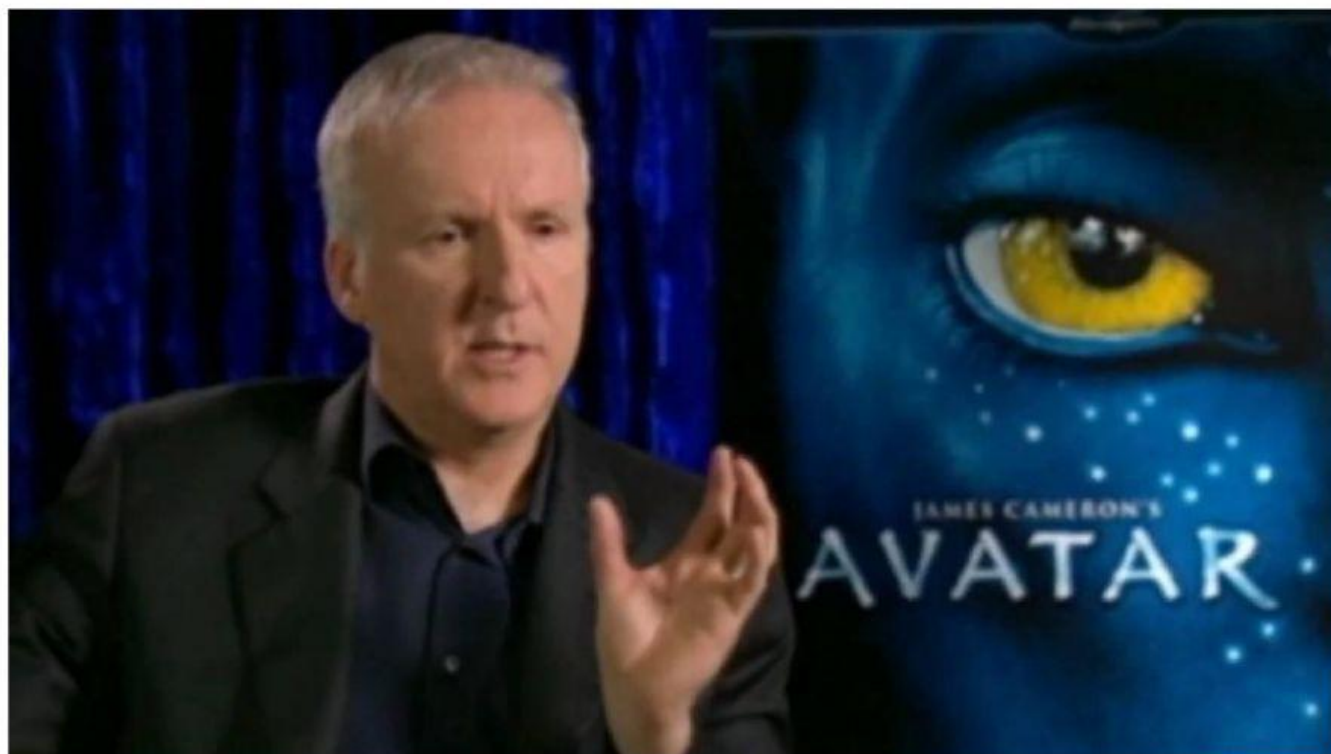




**Complete the summaries of James Cameron's answers to the questions above.**
