

Wish: ao ước.

If only: giá mà, phải chi.

Sau **Wish** và **If only**, người ta dùng mệnh đề chỉ sự ao ước, 1 điều không thật. Có 3 mệnh đề ao ước:

TYPES	FORMS
1. Future wish	S + WISH + S + would / could + V _o IF ONLY + S + would / could + V _o
2. Present Wish	S + WISH + S + V _{ED/2} (BE=> WERE) IF ONLY + S + V _{ED/2} (BE=> WERE)
3. Past wish	S + WISH + S + had V _{ED/3} IF ONLY + S + had V _{ED/3}

- Ex:**
1. I wish I could be an astronaut **in the future.**
 2. I wish I were rich. **(I am poor now.)**
 3. She wishes she hadn't failed her exam last year. **(She failed her exam last year.)**
