Dinosaur data

Dinosaurs lived on Earth for million years ago. Scientists study dinosaur bones to find out how they lived and what they looked like. There are more than 700 different kinds of dinosaurs! Some dinosaurs ate plants and others ate meat. Some walked on two legs and others walked on four legs. Some could fly and others lived in the sea. We know they were all different but no one know what color and pattern they were. This is because there's no dinosaur skin left to study. Dinosaurs disappeared 65 million years ago. Why was this? Some scientists think that a large rock called an asteroid fell to Earth from space. This made the Earth much colder and there was no longer any food for the dinosaur to eat. The most well-known dinosaur was T.Rex (Tyrannosaurus Rex). It was very fierce and it likes to fight and eat the flesh of another dinosaur. All the other dinosaurs were afraid of it. It was 14 meters long and 5.5 m high: bigger than a house. Its strong tail helped it move quickly. But no one knows how fast it can run. Its teeth were 36 centimeters long. The biggest dinosaur was Diplodocus. It was the biggest and tallest dinosaur. It was taller than a tree but it was not very fierce because it was a threats plant. There are no dinosaurs today but you can see dinosaurs skeletons in some natural history museums.
