some 一些 an unknown quantity (more than one) 无可计算的数量 (多于一个)	> Some of the students are in the hall. (positive sentence 肯定句)	> There's some oil in the bottle. (positive sentence 肯定句)
	> Would you like some honey with your tea? (offer 提议) > May I borrow some books? (request 询问)	
any 任何 may refer to one or many things 可以指一个或很多东西	> There aren't any eggs left. (negative sentence 否定句)	> There isn't any water in the jug. (negative sentence 否定句)
	> Do you have any stamps? (question 问题)	
a lot of 很多 large in number 数量很多	> You've got a lot of books. > I've got a lot of toys.	> That's a lot of money. > There was a lot of rain last week.
lots of 许多 means the same as "a lot of" (usually informal) 与 a lot of 的意思一样 (通常是非正式的)	> You've got lots of stamps in your album. > There were lots of people at the mall yesterday.	> We need lots of butter for this recipe. > You need lots of patience to complete this task.
a few 几个 a small number of 指少数的	> There are only a few children in the playground.	<i>(not used with uncountable nouns 不用于不可数名词)</i>
a little 一点 a small number of 指少数的	<i>(not used with countable nouns 不用于可数名词)</i>	> There's only a little time left for us to complete the quiz.

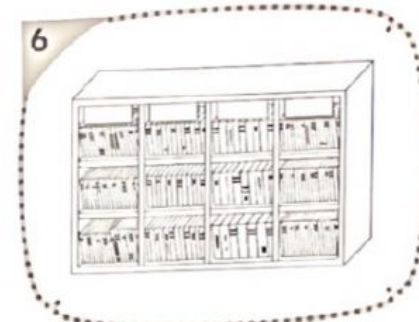

no 没有	no one 没有人 ➤ There was no one at home.	nothing 没有东西 ➤ There's nothing left in the fridge.
