SAVOIR AND CONNAITRE BOTH MEANS TO 'to know' in French.
Both the verbs have different meaning in French. Difference between the two are as follows:

SAVOIR -to know how to do something (skill). It is used to express a skill.
In this case,

It is followed by an infinitive. So, if you want to say 'I know how to swim'

Je sais Nager.

Tu sais lire.

Nous avons danser.

CONNAITRE- To know something or someone. It is always followed by a noun. Unlike, Savoir which is followed by an infinitive.

Je connais Manuel.

Tu connais Linde.

NOTE: Savoir is also used to know something- a fact or information.

Je sais quand il arrive.
