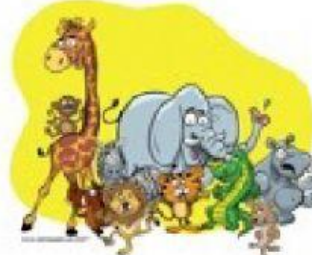


METAPHORS
