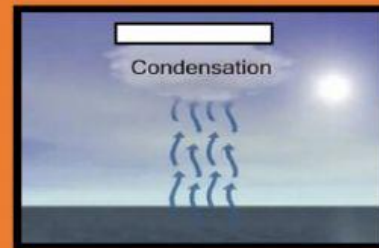
Water falls back into oceans, lakes, rivers and seas. Some precipitation also falls on the ground and is absorbed by the soil. This is called groundwater.

The water vapour collected in the clouds become tiny water droplets when it cools down.

The Sun heats up the water from oceans, lakes and rivers and rises up into the sky as water vapour. This water vapour collects into clouds.

The water droplets move around bumping into each other and growing in size. Then, they fall from the sky in form of rain, snow, sleet or hail.
