The nuclear family, consisting of a mother, father and their children, may be more an American ideal than American reality. Of course, the so-called traditional American family was always more varied than we had been led to believe, reflecting the very different racial, ethnic, class, and religious customs among different American groups, but today diversity is even more obvious.

The most recent government census statistics reveal that only about one third of all **current** American families fits the traditional mold of two parents and their children, and another third

consists of married couples who either have no children or have **none** still living at home. An analysis of the remaining one third of the population reveals that about 30% of the total number of American households are single people, the most common descriptor being woman over sixty- five years of age.
