But in early sixty VSO reduced the number of young people, and older and older, experienced people with different skills went abroad.

Now, more than 20,000 people from Britain have worked abroad as volunteers, some young, others old, some highly skilled men and women. Abroad, they live simply, with the people of the country, and they return to Britain with greatest understanding of other people in other parts of the world.
