Have you ever watched a TV series that made you forget off the gas or even what time of day it is? 'Chernobyl', which dramatises the story of the massive explosion of a nuclear power plant in Ukraine, is a series just like that.

twenty-three minutes past one in the morning on 26th April, 1986 a safety test at a nuclear reactor in Soviet Ukraine went catastrophically wrong. Not only did the reactor stop ,it exploded. Harmful isotopes were taken the wind as far away as Ireland within a week. Adults still remember the terrible news quite a few days after the catastrophe happened.

These events, as well as the Soviet government's questionable reaction to the disaster, are what the HBO's historical drama series 'Chernobyl' tried .

Following the final episode, which aired in America 3rd June, it became the highest-rated television series of all time.

The series was shot in Ukraine and in a partly decommissioned nuclear power plant in Lithuania. Most of the actors are portraying real people as 'Chernobyl' looks at the decisions and possible motives behind their actions. The creators wanted the story of life at the time as it was and they did it incredibly well. The series does a great job of telling the stories of simple bravery and heroism previously unknown to many people, so remember it tonight.
