Lord Byron and a pet bear



George Gordon Byron is one of _____ British poets of all times, well known for his love of animals. During his life, Byron kept a countless number of animals. When Byron _____ at Trinity College, Cambridge, from 1805 to 1808, he even had a bear. At this time, according to the statutes of the college, dogs _____ . Lord Byron was angry with the college rules, so he brought a tame bear as a pet.

The college authorities had an argument with the poet, but since there was no mention of pet bears in the statutes of the college, they had no legal right to expel bear or its owner. Byron walked the bear on a chain and treated it like a dog. When Byron left Cambridge, in 1808, he _____ the bear with him to his house in London.
