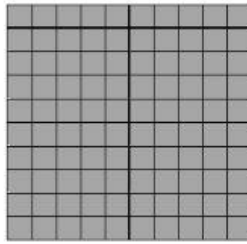

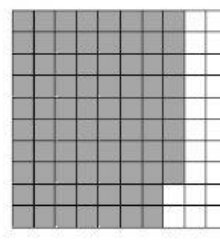
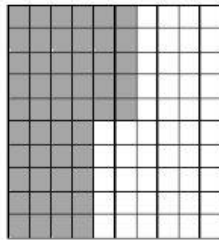
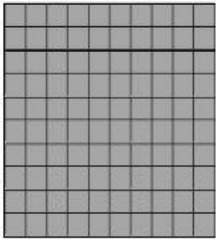
3. This model is shaded to represent one whole.
