



**EX. 1 From one language to another**

Finding an accurate (1) TRANSLATE \_\_\_\_\_ from one language to another is not always easy and the job of an interpreter can be (2) PREDICT \_\_\_\_\_. The email \_\_\_\_\_ from Alex.
6. Jill described her holiday to me. (TOLD)  
Jill \_\_\_\_\_ her holiday.

7. You shouldn't call her late at night. (OUGHT)

You \_\_\_\_\_ call her late at night.

8. I'm almost certain this phone is broken because I can't hear anything. (MUST)

This phone \_\_\_\_\_ because I can't hear anything.
