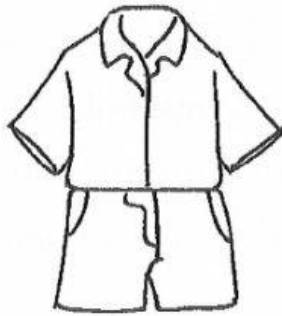


Fabrics
