

Let's Practise

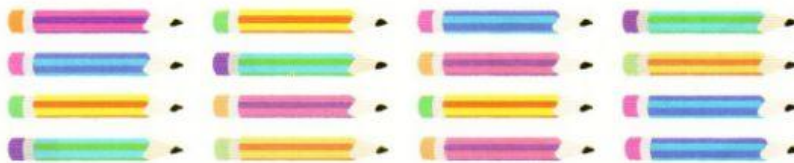
- 1 Pack 12 sweets equally into 4 bags.
How many sweets are there in each bag?



$$12 \div 4 = \square$$

There are $\square$ sweets in each bag.

- 2 Put 16 pencils into groups of 4.
How many groups of pencils are there?



$$16 \div 4 = \square$$

There are $\square$ groups of pencils.

- 3 What are the missing numbers?

(a) $\square \times 4 = 8$

(b) $\square \times 4 = 28$

$$8 \div 4 = \square$$

$$28 \div 4 = \square$$

- 4 Jonah puts 36 cherries equally into 4 cups.
How many cherries are there in each cup?

$$36 \div 4 = \square$$

There are $\square$ cherries in each cup.
