

Conditional Sentences – First Type.

A conditional sentence is made up of two parts : The **IF clause** and the **MAIN clause**.
We can put these two clauses in the order in which we want .

If clause	Main Clause
If it rains	I'll stay at home.

Main Clause	If clause
I'll stay at home	If it rains.

The Verb in the If clause is always **PRESENT** but in the **Main clause** we must use **WILL / WILL NOT / 'LL / WON'T** /

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The First Conditional expresses a future action that depends on a present condition. "If Tom comes " (the present condition) , something will happen : " We'll go to the cinema "comes "
