Marilyn appeared in 29 films. Comedy and musicals were her speciality. Some of

her famous songs  are 'Diamonds are a Girl's Best Friend' and 'My Heart Belongs to Daddy'.

Marilyn married  three times. Two of her husbands



were famous: Joe DiMaggio, a baseball player, and Arthur Miller, a writer .

Marilyn died in 1962. She was only 36.
