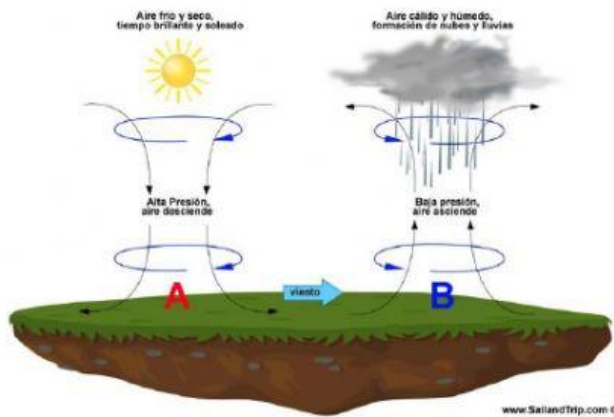

The weight of the air in a particular place.

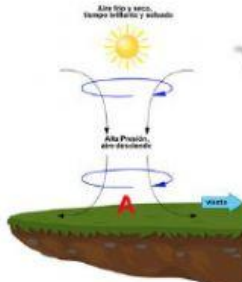
4. ISOBARS

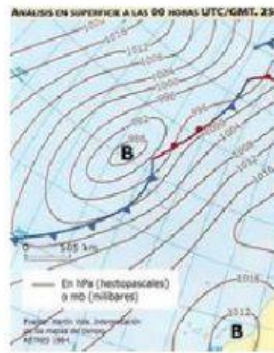
Are areas with a higher average pressure. They are represented with an A on the weather maps and cause stable weather.



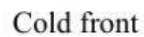
5. ANTICYCLONES

Is air in motion.

Areas of lower average pressure, they are represented with an B and they cause unstable weather.

Instrument that measures wind direction.

9. ANEMOMETER



Instrument that measures wind speed.
