BOY RESCUED FROM FIRE



In the early hours of Saturday morning, a Greater Manchester fireman carried a six year old boy from his burning home in Urban Road, Denton.

The boy, Ryan Jones had been home alone whilst his parents, Mick and Norma, were out playing Bingo. Ryan was trapped in the bedroom of his home for 30 minutes before firemen were able to rescue him.

Severe Smoke

The smoke from the fire was so severe that the firemen wore breathing apparatus and entered the house in pairs. An eyewitness stated that they were shocked that anyone could have come out of the building alive.

The boy was rushed to Tameside hospital where he is being treated for burns and smoke inhalation. His parents are currently being questioned at Denton Police Station. Police Commissioner, George Johnson told our reporter, "It is very likely that Mr and Mrs Jones will face charges over this incident. Ryan should not have been left in the house on his own."

Started in Living Room

Fire investigators have not finished their enquiries, but initial thoughts are that the blaze started in the living room of the property. They found evidence of an electrical outlet that had been overloaded with plugs. This could have been the source of the fire that almost cost Ryan his life.
