● **All** = tout(e), tous, toutes

He ate all the bread / all the sandwiches.



● **The whole** /həʊl/

= la totalité (de)

→ *The whole + singulier dénombrable*

He drank the whole bottle.

Il a bu **toute** la bouteille.



● **Every** = chaque (tous)

→ *every + singulier*

Every problem has its solution.

Chaque problème a sa solution.

(= Tous les problèmes ont leur solution.)



● **Each** = chaque, chacun(e)

→ *each + singulier*

Each situation is particular.

Chaque situation est particulière.



● **Both** /bəʊθ/ = les deux

I've met both brothers.

J'ai rencontré **les deux** frères.
