
# Two-Step Word Problems: Addition and Subtraction

## Practice 1 Two-Step Word Problems


Solve.

- How many boxes of peaches did Uncle Sayid sell?




Uncle Sayid had \_\_\_\_\_ boxes of fruits at first.




Uncle Sayid sold \_\_\_\_\_ boxes of peaches.

Lila has \_\_\_\_\_ movie tickets.




They have \_\_\_\_\_ movie tickets altogether.
