*Sorry, maybe next time.*

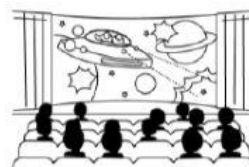

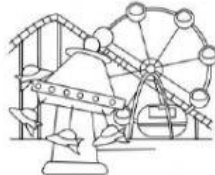
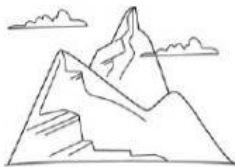
#### Dialogue 1
