

PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE (in, at, on)

- **in** – big places (towns, cities, provinces and countries.)
Also, “in the world.” – this refers to the place.

- **at** – for points of reference or places in a big place.

- **on** – for anything that represents a line or surface.
Also, “on the Earth.” - this refers to the surface.

Also, on the bus, on a plane etc.

These modes of transport follow a fixed route or line.
