Property name	Property description
	The property states that the order in which numbers are added or multiplied does not change the sum or product.
	The property states that to multiply a sum or difference by a number, multiply each term inside the parentheses by the number outside the parentheses.
	The property states that the way in which numbers are grouped when they are added or multiplied does not change the sum or product.
	When 0 is added to any number, the sum is the number.
	When any number is multiplied by 1, the product is the number.
	When any number is multiplied by 0, the product is 0
