*Remember: the first number tells you where to start on the number line. The sign that follows tells you which direction you move on the number line. And the number following the sign tells you how many places you move on the number line. **don't forget to write your sign in your answer***

$$8. - 12 + 10 =$$

$$9. - 4 + 5 =$$

$$10. - 3 - 8 =$$
