Read the text about some iconic buildings in Barcelona and use the correct form of past simple.

BARCELONA CATHEDRAL

In the 13th century King Jaume II, the Just, _____ (decide) to build a temple over the remains of an earlier Romanesque church. The work, _____ (take) more than 150 years, but never _____ (interrupt) the religious services. As a result of civil wars and the black death that _____ (occur) in Barcelona, the construction of the cathedral _____ (progress) slowly. It _____ (be) not until 1460 that the main building of the cathedral **was finally finished**. The Gothic façade **was added** in 1889, and the most recent part, the cathedral's central tower, **was completed** in 1913.



GRAN TEATRE DEL LICEU

The Gran Teatre del Liceu officially _____ (open) on April 4, 1847, following the model of the grand theaters of Italy, and **was designed** to accommodate 4,000 audience members. It immediately _____ (become) a symbol of the emerging Catalan middle-class. On April 9, 1861, a fire _____ (destroy) a good part of the stage and auditorium. Its restoration **was carried out** by the architect Josep Oriol Mestres. On November 7, 1893, as a result of social tensions, and amidst a series of workers' revolts, an anarchist _____ (throw) two bombs into the auditorium during the second act of Rossini's "Guillaume Tell" opera. This violent act _____ (kill) 20 spectators and _____ (injure) more.



THE GÜELL PALACE

The Güell Palace **was designed** by the famous architect Antoni Gaudí. It _____ (open) to the public in 2011 after 7 years of renovation. Palau Güell _____ (be) the town house of Gaudí's patron, Count Eusebi Güell, who _____ (order) the construction of the building in 1885 and _____ (make) it his family home for 20 years. During the Spanish civil war from 1936 to 1939 Palau Güell **was used** as a police station. After that it **was owned** by the Barcelona Council, who _____ (use) it for a theatre institute 'l'Institut del Teatre.'
