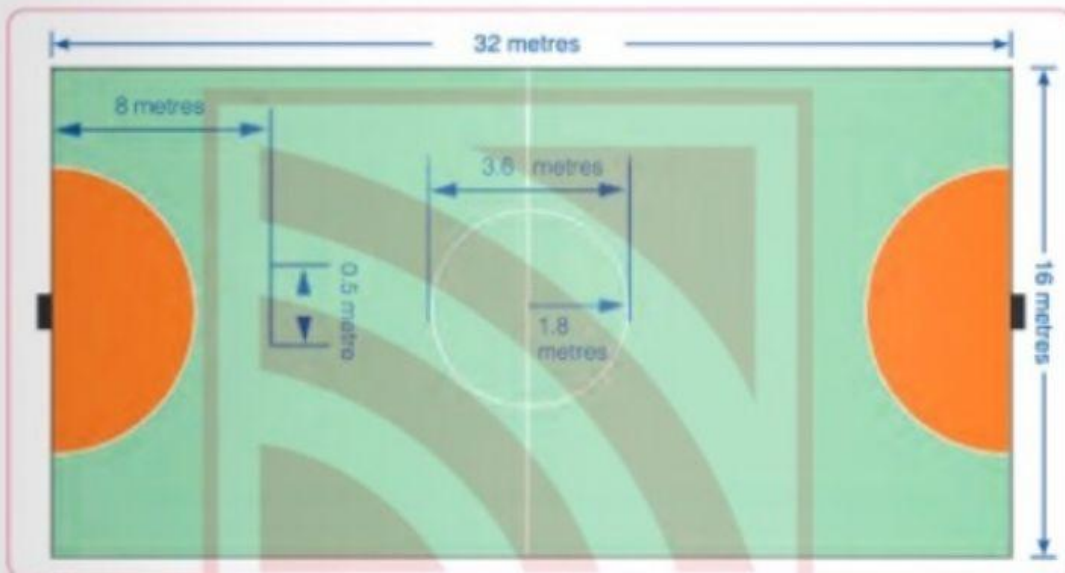


Basic information

1 Players: There are two teams consisting of 7 players each, 6 court players – one of which is a goalkeeper who stays within the goal or basket area and a player who holds the basket and stands on a chair on the opponent's side. There are also 5 substitute players.

2 Court:



The rectangle court is 16 metres wide and 32 metres long. The 0.5-metre long penalty line is 8 metres far apart from a midpoint of the end-line.
