- A two-liter, empty, soda bottle
- Modeling clay
- A funnel
- 1 liter of warm water
- Red food coloring
- Vinegar
- Baking soda
- Liquid dish detergent

## MAKE A VOLCANO!

\_\_\_\_\_ Pour several tablespoons of vinegar into the volcano. Then, move away from the volcano and watch it erupt.

\_\_\_\_\_ once you have made your volcano, use the funnel to pour one liter of warm water into the bottle in the center.

\_\_\_\_\_ add about two tablespoons of baking soda to the mixture in the bottle.

\_\_\_\_\_ after adding the food coloring, put in a few drops of detergent.

\_\_\_\_\_ use modeling clay to make a large cone-shaped volcano around the soda bottle. Be careful not to get any clay in the bottle or in the mouth of the bottle.

\_\_\_\_\_ ass a few drops of red food coloring to the water in the volcano.
